Yarmouth is the beginning of both the Evangeline Trail (Route 1) and the Lighthouse Route (Route 3). Speed limits vary on the province's scenic trails. On the 100 series highways, the speed limit is generally 100km/hr (60 miles/hr.) but watch for reductions in speed through populated areas. The highways are almost exclusively patrolled by the Royal Canadian Mounted Police. The seat belt law is enforced in Nova Scotia. There is a fine for not wearing seatbelts. When travelling through towns in rural Nova Scotia, visitors are often surprised by people walking out in front of traffic. It is our custom to stop for pedestrian traffic in crosswalks, so be prepared to stop.
